## POLICIES & FAQs

<b>OUTSIDE FOOD &amp; DRINK</b>	Outside food and drinks are not allowed.
<b>REFUNDS</b>	No refunds will be granted after posted showtime.
<b>RECORDING</b>	Recording any portion of a movie is a violation of federal law. Please refrain from camera use in the auditorium.
<b>BAGS</b>	AMC reserves the right to inspect or refuse bags or packages.
<b>DRUGS &amp; ALCOHOL</b>	Intoxication or impairment from alcohol or drugs is not allowed. The possession or use of recreational drugs on the property, the possession of alcohol not purchased on AMC premises, and the consumption of alcohol outside of designated areas are also prohibited.
<b>COSTUMES &amp; FACE COVERING</b>	Weapons, even “prop” weapons, are not allowed. Face paint, helmets, and full masks or hoods that obscure the face are also prohibited (partial face coverings worn for medical or religious reasons are acceptable).

## ID POLICY

Be prepared to show a valid ID for the following:

<b>ALCOHOL PURCHASES</b>	The minimum legal age for purchasing and consuming alcoholic beverages within AMC is 21.
<b>R-RATED FILMS</b>	Guests under 17 must be accompanied by a guardian aged 21 or older who remains throughout the duration of the show. Children under 6 are not allowed in showings after 6pm.
<b>A-LIST RESERVATIONS</b>	A-List ticket reservations require a valid photo ID (unexpired, issued by a school or governmental agency) that includes full name. This is required with every visit.
